- 5. So long as the Defendant makes the payment specified in paragraph 1 above, no interest shall be charged on the outstanding balance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Judgment is non-dischargeable and is excluded from a discharge in these proceedings or any subsequent proceedings attempting to discharge Defendant's obligations.
