**NONDISCHARGEABLE JUDGMENT**

Based upon the Stipulation of the Parties, referenced as document #6, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The sum of \$2,500.00 owed by the Defendant to Plaintiff is found to be nondischargeable and Plaintiff is granted judgment against Defendant in this amount.
2. The non-discharged sum of \$2,500.00 shall be paid as follows: **the sum of \$75.00 per month, each month for 33 months and final payment of \$25.00 on the 34<sup>th</sup> month, with the first payment due upon execution of the stipulation.** The remaining payments shall be due on the same day of each month thereafter.

3. Payments are to be made to:



Plaintiff or its agents may send monthly bills and invoices as a courtesy reminder to Defendant.

4. In the event Defendant defaults in payments, Plaintiff shall be entitled to declare the sum of \$2,500.00, immediately due and payable.
5. Defendant acknowledges and stipulates that if Defendant fails to make any payment as agreed, the remaining \$2,500.00, less any payments made, shall be immediately due and payable.
6. Plaintiff will refrain from pursuing its rights under this agreement so long as Defendant continues to make payment on a regular, timely basis. If Defendant defaults, however, Plaintiff shall have the right to pursue any legally available remedy without further notice, and without need for further relief from the automatic stay in any bankruptcy proceeding in which the Defendant is a Debtor pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(c)(2)(C).

7. The parties shall pay their own attorney fees and costs in this matter.
