**FINAL JUDGMENT ON NAVY FEDERAL CREDIT UNION'S  
COMPLAINT TO DETERMINE DISCHARGEABILITY OF SPECIFIC DEBT**

THIS CAUSE CAME ON for consideration Motion pursuant to the Order Granting Plaintiff's Motion to Approve Stipulation in Settlement of Adversary Complaint (Related Main Case Doc. 41). This Court has approved the Stipulation and has directed that a separate Final Judgment be entered in the proceeding. A Separate Judgment in conformance with Federal Rules of Civil Procedure shall be entered in the cause. Therefore, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. A Final Judgment is entered in favor of the Plaintiff Navy Federal Credit Union and against the Defendant Alejandro Mendez in the amount of \$4,000.

2, The Final Judgment shall be a determination that the Defendant's debt to Plaintiff shall survive and shall not be subject to the general Bankruptcy Discharge (Doc. # 21) entered on October 24, 2014.

3. The Parties shall abide by their rights and duties under the Stipulation in Settlement of the Adversary Proceeding and provided that Debtor performs the Stipulation the Plaintiff may take no action. However, should Defendant default, Plaintiff may seek to enforce the Judgment plus interest at the Judgment interest rate of .0335% without violation of the discharge injunction or automatic stay of the Debtor's bankruptcy case.

4. Each Party shall bear its own costs and attorney's fees.

5. Execution may issue.
