JUDGMENT OF NON-DISCHARGEABILITY

THIS MATTER, having come before the Court on the Stipulation Regarding Non-Dischargeability of Claim of Escambia County Clerk of Circuit Court (the “Stipulation”) (ECF 147) and the Court, having reviewed the Stipulation and the Court file, having acknowledged that the Debtor, MARCUS NELSON MAY (the “Debtor”) stipulates to the relief granted in this Judgment, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Debtor’s personal liability to Creditor, Escambia County Clerk of Circuit Court (the “Clerk”), 190 W Government Street Pensacola, Florida 32502, pursuant to that certain Final Judgment for Fines, Costs, and Additional Charges entered December 5, 2018 by the Escambia County Circuit Court in the initial principal

sum of \$5,571,574.69 (the “Clerk Judgment”) is a non-dischargeable obligation which is hereby excepted from any order of this Court discharging the Debtor of personal liability for dischargeable pre-petition debts.

2. This Judgment of Non-Dischargeability is without prejudice to the right of the Debtor to move to vacate this Judgment in the event any court reverses the Clerk Judgment and extinguishes the Debtor’s liability to the Clerk pursuant to the Clerk Judgment.
