

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**FINAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT FOR THE PLAINTIFF (Docs. 42 & 73)**



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ORDERED:

**ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S  
MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT (Doc. 42)**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the Motions for Summary Judgment filed by both the Plaintiff, Mary W. Colón, Chapter 7 Trustee and the Defendant, Envision Credit Union. The Trustee asserts the estate is entitled to damages pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §549(a) for an unauthorized post-petition transfer of an estate asset to Defendant. Trustee seeks damages against the initial transferee under 11 U.S.C. §550(a)(1). The Defendant has asserted the granting of relief from the automatic stay allowed the transfer of property and that the property had no value. For the reasons announced in open court at the pre-trial hearing on this matter on March 31, 2016, Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment should be granted. Accordingly, it is

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ORDERED:

1. The Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. 42) is GRANTED.
2. The Defendant's Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. 38) is DENIED.
3. Plaintiff is entitled to entry of a judgment in the amount of \$2,500.00 plus costs.
4. If this order is appealed, the Court reserves the right to review the transcript and supplement this Order as necessary.
