DEFAULT FINAL JUDGMENT


THIS CAUSE being before the Court upon Plaintiff S&G Enterprises, LLC's ("S&G") Motion for Final Default Judgment ("Motion") against Debtor John Milton Hunnicutt, Jr. ("Hunnicutt"), and the Court having determined that S&G is entitled to final default judgment against Hunnicutt pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 55 and entered an Order in accordance therewith,

IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED:

1. The debt owed to S&G Enterprises, LLC, whose address is 1101 E. Wood Street, Paris, Tennessee 38242, by John M. Hunnicutt, Jr., whose address is 9768 Parker Lake Circle, Navarre, Florida 32566, as set forth in the Henry County, Tennessee, Judgment attached hereto as Exhibit A (“Tennessee Judgment”), is determined NON-DISCHARGEABLE pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 523(a)(4) and (a)(6).

2. Pursuant to the terms of the Tennessee Judgment, S&G shall recover from Hunnicutt three thousand, seven hundred ninety-six and 05/100ths (\$3,796.05) dollars; the costs of collection since entry of the Tennessee Judgment (including reasonable attorney’s fees and costs); any taxes; and post-judgment interest at the rate of ten percent (10%) per annum.
